Milling Machine


You will have noticed that the metal shop has had a bit of re-arranging and that a "new" milling machine sits proudly there.

Toolbox Meeting

The Committee meets on the second Monday of every month. This is followed by a BBQ and a Toolbox Meeting. The purpose of this meeting is to provide feedback to the members and similarly receive feedback from the members.

The following issues were raised at the April meeting.

Table Saw – care must be taken by all so as not to cause the safety mechanism to go off which is caused by using moist timber or for the fact that the machine is designed to ensure no one is hurt. The cost of the kit is now over \$320.

Costs are rising for all of our consumables – bandsaw blades, glue, bobbin sander sleeves, etc.

Milling Machine – now that this machine has arrived a further assessment is required before any member can use the machine. Members must have full metalwork assessment prior to being assessed for the milling machine. Kerry Whitworth has undertaken the role of Assessor.

Mentoring Programme – this programme run for students from Labrador Sate School has been running very successfully for over 12 years. It is run by Dennis Nunn and Graeme Laing and they need support to keep it going.
